Prelims Warm Up Procedures

The Triton Pool pool will be open for general warmup during the scheduled times only. The south side of Triton Pool will be continuously open for warm up from the beginning of the warmup session and throughout the prelim sessions. **The Canyonview Pool will be open for warm up from 9am-11am on Saturday and Sunday only**. Teams will be assigned a warm up time slot lasting 25 minutes. Any warmup time changes will be announced in presidents' meetings and through Discord.

Finals Warm up Procedures

The north side of Triton Pool pool will be open for general warmup during the scheduled times only, and the south side of Triton Pool pool will be continuously open for warm up from the beginning of the warmup session and throughout the session. Teams will not be assigned warm up time slots for finals. Any warmup time changes will be announced in presidents' meetings and through Discord.

Assigned Team Seating

Teams are assigned to seating areas, either on the bleachers on Triton Pool or in a section next to Canyonview Pool. If assigned to the bleachers on Triton Pool, teams will be given a specific section of the bleachers, which may be shared with other teams. If assigned to Canyonview Pool, teams will be placed either on the grass section of Canyonview Pool, the patio at the north-end, or in the grass sections west of Canyonview Pool. Teams will be given their assigned seating information in their check-in packet. Labels and tape on the bleachers or posters will mark team sections.

Patio furniture is available for teams sitting on the patio, located on the north end of Canyonview Pool. Please treat the furniture with respect and return them to their original positions between sessions.



Results

Results will be posted on deck on the wall below the scoreboard on the North Wall of Triton Pool.

Awards

Team Awards will be presented at the conclusion of Sunday evening finals. Individual medals will be handed out at the meet referee tent. Awards for Saturday and Sunday events will be presented right after the A final of each men's event. The top 3 athletes in each event need to be ready to receive their award following the conclusion of the men's A final. For example, the top three finishers in the 100 breaststroke for men and women will receive their award at the conclusion of the men's 100 breaststroke A final. Awards for timed finals events will be presented before the first relay medal presentation. Team Awards will be presented at the conclusion of Sunday evening finals.

Facility Policies and Procedures

Facility Entrance - Participants and Spectators

Participants and Spectators can enter the building through the south entrance adjacent to the aquatic center entrance.

Athletes will only be allowed into the facility to access the locker rooms. All outdoor walkways will be open.

Spectators will use the south end as their ONLY walkway between the facility and designated spectator seating. Spectators needing to access the restrooms will enter the facility at the south end of Triton pool and make a left.

Participants and Spectators are not allowed to use any other entrance or exit to the facility.

Moving Through the Facility

The Canyonview Aquatic Center will be open for regular patrons throughout the weekend. With that in mind, note that the Canyonview Pool will not be available for swimmers after 11am during the prelims sessions and the entirety of the finals sessions. The Locker Rooms on the north end next to the entrance to the Canyonview Pool will be open to the public and spectators. Athletes are advised to use the Locker rooms located on the south end of the facility in the hallway.

Facility Policies & Logistics

- UC San Diego requires all athletes to sign a Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement Waiver to compete at our facilities. Any swimmer that does not fill out the form will not be allowed to compete at the meet.
- All pool rules are listed on the facility wall next to the locker rooms. Swimmers and spectators are required to abide by all pool rules. Any individual that does not follow these rules will be asked to leave the facility for the remainder of the meet.
- Certain areas of the deck are restricted to competing athletes, registered coaches, officials, event staff, and meet volunteers. These areas will be blocked off. No parents, spectators, or members of the general public will be allowed in these areas except at the request of a Meet Director or Meet Referee.
- Please keep all trash picked up in your team and spectator seating areas and stay away from restricted areas. If a swimmer is found in a restricted area, the swimmer will be asked to leave the facility and may be pulled from the remainder of the meet.
- Vandalism will not be tolerated. Any individual caught vandalizing the facility will be asked to leave the facility for the remainder of this meet.
- Belongings should be removed from the deck between sessions and overnight for cleaning.
- No tape is allowed in the tile area for hanging team banners or any other use. Zip ties and bungee cords are acceptable for this purpose.
- UC San Diego is a smoke-free campus.
- The lost & found is located at the front desk of Canyonview Aquatic Center.



Presidents Meeting Location

Please have a club representative attend the President's Meeting which will take place 30 minutes before the start of each session. The President's meeting will take place at the Canyonview Classroom located in the Canyonview Admin Building west of Triton pool.

Volunteering Information

Volunteer check-in at the meet will be located at the meet admin tent beneath the scoreboard. All volunteers should plan on checking in AT LEAST 15 MINUTES prior to the start of their shift. Further directions will be given to volunteers upon arrival.
